What's Included?

1 - CPI Validator with Stacker*

CPI Validator accepts \$1, \$5, \$10 & \$20's. Can be programmed for other currencies. CPI Validator models currently compatible are: AE2632, 2602 with down stacker, T702, and T602. 500 note stacker included. Upgrade to a 1,000 note stacker for \$55 List.

2 - Hoppers w/ Extensions**

Each hopper holds 5,300 quarters/tokens (3,600 \$1 coins). Total capacity is 10,600 quarters/tokens (7,200 \$1 coins).

1 - Universal Board

American Changer's Universal Board allows one validator/ two hoppers with one power supply

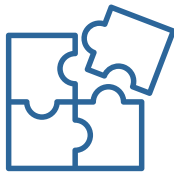
Kit includes brackets, mounting plates, hopper extensions, chutes, and harnesses.
